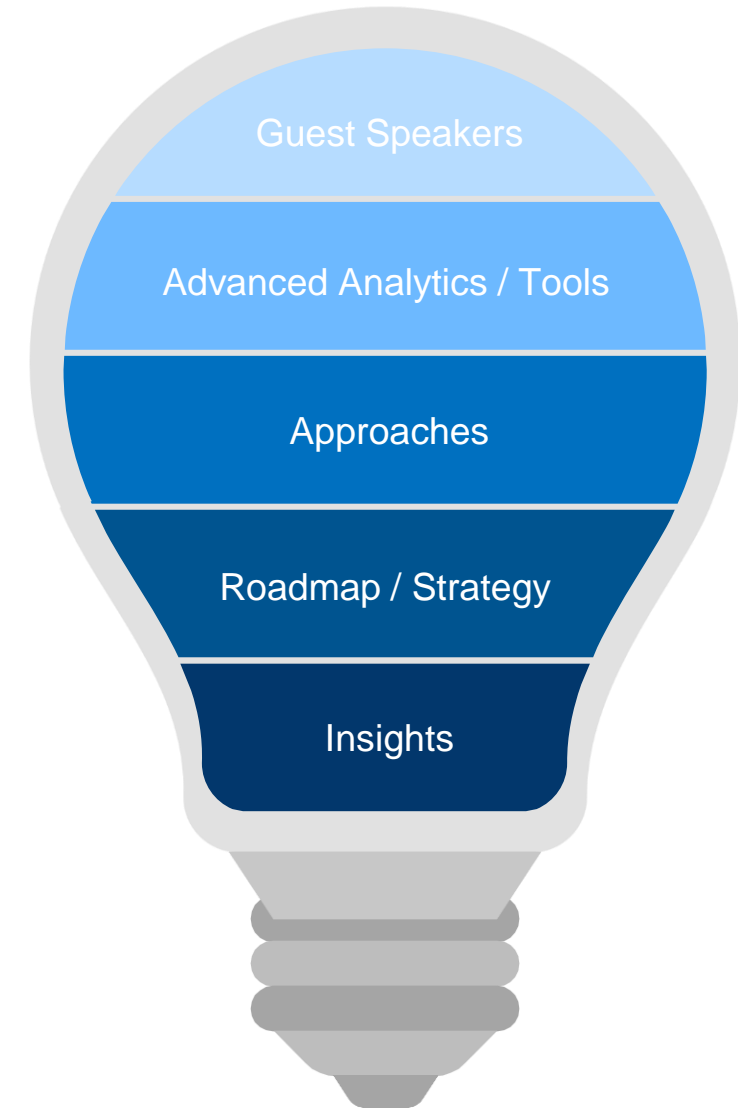
- Refine and acquire analytics capabilities

- Access analytics resources and tools



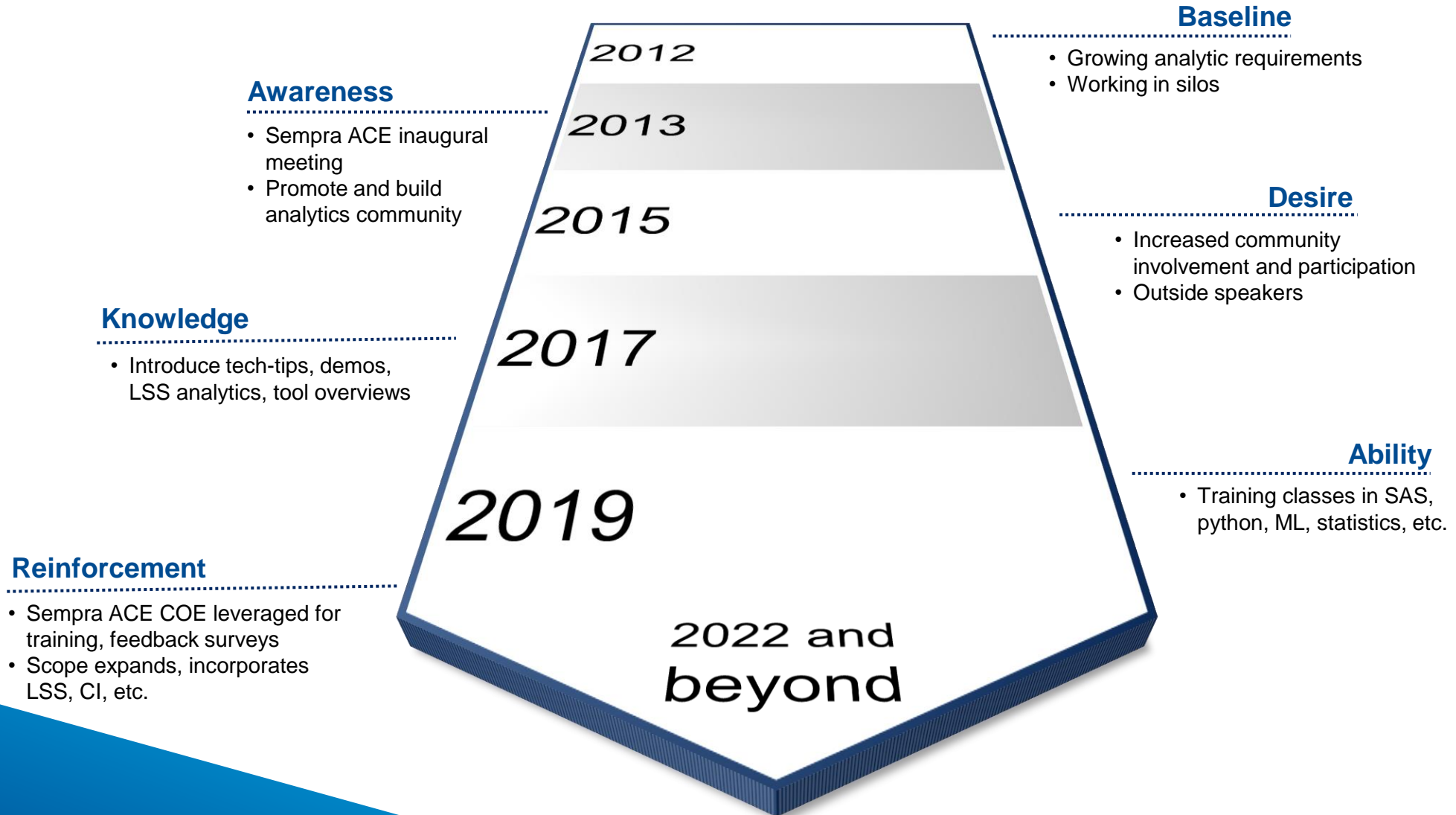
Sempra ACE Meeting Topics and Highlights

 - Brain teasers

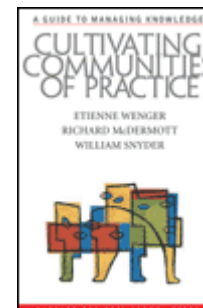


ACE Evolution ADKAR
